

MHCM - MCAT Score Reporting Instructions

How to report scores depends on the date of the exam:

- **For test dates 1991 to today: use Method 1**
- **For test dates pre-1991: use Method 2**

Method 1, to report MCAT scores from 1991 to today to SOPHAS:

MCAT scores from *1991 to today* are sent electronically from AAMC to SOPHAS. Paper copies are not accepted. You must use the AAMC website to have your MCAT scores released to SOPHAS. On your SOPHAS application, you must make sure that you have self-reported your MCAT score in the “Standardized Tests” section, accessed via “Academic History” on your SOPHAS homepage, and included your AAMC ID#.

Method 2, to report MCAT scores *pre-1991* (note the two steps):

Reporting MCAT scores from *before 1991* is a two-part process. First, self-report scores in SOPHAS; there are two ways to self-report, as outlined below. Second, send official paper score reports to the **Harvard T. H. Chan School Admissions Office, 158 Longwood Ave, Boston, MA 02115-5810**.

Step 1: Self-report your pre-1991 MCAT scores. Choose from ONE of the following **two options**. Log in to your SOPHAS application, then either:

Step 1, Option 1 - upload a scan of an unofficial MCAT score report: Select “Program Materials”, choose our program, then select the “Documents” tab, scroll to “Standardized Test Score Reports” and choose “Add Document” directly below. At the next screen you can upload the scan of your scores from your computer using “Choose File”. Once completed, you will be able to see the file listed in SOPHAS and may confirm it opens as needed.

Step 1, Option 2 - manually enter the scores: Select “Supporting Information,” followed by “Additional Experiences.” In the first box labeled “Other Information,” please enter the test date along with each category and score. Finally, at the bottom of the page choose “Save and Continue.”

These scores are self-reported and must be verified by an official score report sent to Harvard Chan via Step 2.

Step 2: Request official paper report be sent to Harvard Chan Admissions: The AAMC requires a paper request form to request official pre-1991 MCAT scores. The AAMC form is located here (please note the required fees): <https://aamc->

The fastest method is to enter your Credit Card information on the form and to fax it. The recipient for the score is Harvard Chan Admissions Office, 158 Longwood Ave, Boston, MA 02115-5810. *Note: For pre-1991 MCAT scores **do not** use the Standardized Tests section (under “Academic History”) of SOPHAS.
